

Junior Department

RULES:

1. Open to any youth, under 19 years of age, as of July 1, 2008.
2. All entries will be judged based on the DANISH SYSTEM of JUDGING unless otherwise stated.
3. 4-H members may enter in the Junior Department only if they are not enrolled in that project.
4. All entries within the Junior Department should be entered on one entry form.
5. All entry forms must be signed by a parent or legal guardian.
6. Please list the exhibitors birth date on the entry form.
7. Items should be brought to the Fair on/in disposable containers, i.e. aluminum tins, cardboard cake forms, paper plates, etc. Do Not Bring items in or on something that you want returned.

JUNIOR AWARDS

The following special awards will be presented to outstanding projects and/or Exhibitors for entries in the Napa Town & Country Fair. Winner list will be posted in Zinfandel Hall by 4PM August 9th. Winners of any Special Awards are encouraged to attend the Awards Program on Sunday, August 10th at 2:00 pm in the Livestock Show Arena.

Awards will be determined by a count of ribbons received in a certain division(s). The count will be as follows:

- 10 Points for Best of Show
- 5 Points for each Blue Ribbon
- 3 Points for each Red Ribbon
- 1 Point for each White Ribbon

Exhibitors must have at least 2 entries in a category to be considered for a special award. In case of a tie, the award will be divided. In the event that the award cannot be divided, a committee of two will be asked to break the tie. An exhibitor can only receive one Special Award in the Junior Department (other than livestock).

Junior Clothing Award—presented by the Napa Valley Exposition.

Junior Arts Award—presented by the Napa Valley Exposition in memory of our dear friend Evelyn Botelho.

Junior Crafts Award—presented by the Napa Valley Exposition in memory of our dear friend Evelyn Botelho.

Junior Foods Award—presented by Napa Valley Exposition.

Junior Agriculture/Horticulture Award—presented by Grace Methven.

Junior Photography Award—presented by the Napa Valley Exposition.

The Evelyn Botelho Memorial Outstanding Female and Male Exhibitor—presented by the 4-H County Council of Napa. A plaque and \$50.00 will be presented to each of the winners. Please note that this award may not be received by the same exhibitor two years in a row, i.e. an exhibitor who received this award in 2007 will not be eligible in 2008.
