- 5 Medium - Twelve (12") to Eighteen (18") inches high or wide, Deciduous such as Maple, Elm, or Broadleaf Evergreen, one tree, any style, shown in a suitable container.
- 6 Large - Over Eighteen (18") inches high or wide, Deciduous such as Maple, Elm, or Broadleaf Evergreen, one tree, any style, shown in a suitable container.
- 7 Large - Over Eighteen (18") inches high or wide, Junipers, Pines, Cedars or other Conifer, one tree, any style, shown in a suitable container.
- 8 Group Planting - Two or more of one species of tree, any style, shown in a suitable container.
- 9 Planting of a Tree - Any species, on, in or over a rock.
- 10 Miniature Landscape - Any size, any number of species, shown in a suitable container.
- 11 Cascade - A planting of a tree, any species with trunk turned downward to extend below the bottom of container.
