RULES:

1. All entries in the Home Arts Department must be home prepared, canned or packaged by the exhibitor within one year of the opening date of the fair.
2. Items may not have been previously exhibited at the Napa Town and Country Fair.
3. Exhibitors entering in a Professional Division, (i.e.: Cake Decorating), may not enter in any amateur categories directly related to that division (i.e.: layer cakes).
4. Items should be brought to the Fair on/in disposable containers, i.e. aluminum tins, cardboard cake forms, paper plates, etc. Do Not Bring items in or on something that you want returned.

SPECIAL AWARDS HOMEMAKER OF THE YEAR

The Napa Valley Exposition will award \$100.00 to the OVERALL HOMEMAKER OF THE YEAR. Exhibitors wishing to qualify for this award must enter in all four categories of the Home Arts Department: Baked Goods, Clothing, Preserved Foods and Textiles in order to qualify.

Points will be awarded based on awards made by the judges, with 3 points awarded for 1st, 2 points awarded for 2nd and 1 point awarded for a 3rd place.

Exhibitors wishing to be considered for HOMEMAKER OF THE YEAR should clearly mark so on their entry form. Ties will be broken at the Judge's discretion.
