

# Junior Department

## RULES:

1. Open to any youth, under 19 years of age, as of July 1, 2010.
2. All entries will be judged based on the DANISH SYSTEM of JUDGING unless otherwise stated.
3. 4-H members may enter in the Junior Department only if they are not enrolled in that project.
4. All entries within the Junior Department should be entered on one entry form.
5. All entry forms must be signed by a parent or legal guardian.
6. Please list the exhibitor's birth date on the entry form.
7. Items should be brought to the Fair on/in disposable containers, i.e. aluminum tins, cardboard cake forms, paper plates, etc. Do Not Bring items in or on something that you want returned.

## JUNIOR AWARDS

The following special awards will be presented to outstanding projects and/or Exhibitors for entries in the Napa Town & Country Fair. Winner list will be posted in Zinfandel Hall by 4PM August 14<sup>th</sup>. Winners of any Special Awards are encouraged to attend the Awards Program on Sunday, August 15th at 2:00 pm in the Livestock Show Arena.

Awards will be determined by a count of ribbons received in a certain division(s). The count will be as follows:

- 10 Points for Best of Show
- 5 Points for each Blue Ribbon
- 3 Points for each Red Ribbon
- 1 Point for each White Ribbon

Exhibitors must have at least 2 entries in a category to be considered for a special award. An exhibitor can only receive one Special Award in the Junior or 4-H Departments (other than livestock).

**The Evelyn Botelho Memorial Outstanding Female and Male Exhibitor**—presented by the 4-H County Council of Napa. A plaque and \$50.00 will be presented to each of the winners. Please note that this award may not be received by the same exhibitor two years in a row, i.e. an exhibitor who received this award in 2009 will not be eligible in 2010.

\*\*Award based on the total number of ribbon counts in both Junior and 4-H division (other than livestock).
